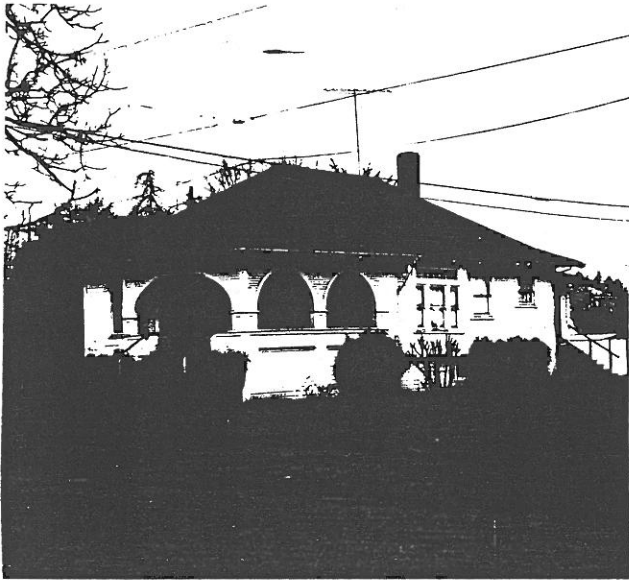

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

This single story bungalow style residence is constructed in a box shape, with a front porch projected out from the southeast corner. This porch has elliptical arches on pedestals, wide front stairs and rounded brackets below a hip roof. To the left is a double-hung window with a multi-light top sash. The building is clad with horizontal shiplap siding with corner boards. The front porch wraps around to the side elevation where two more elliptical arches are located. There is a square bay window located in the center of the facade which features a large one over one, double-hung window, smaller ones at each side and a multi-light transom.
