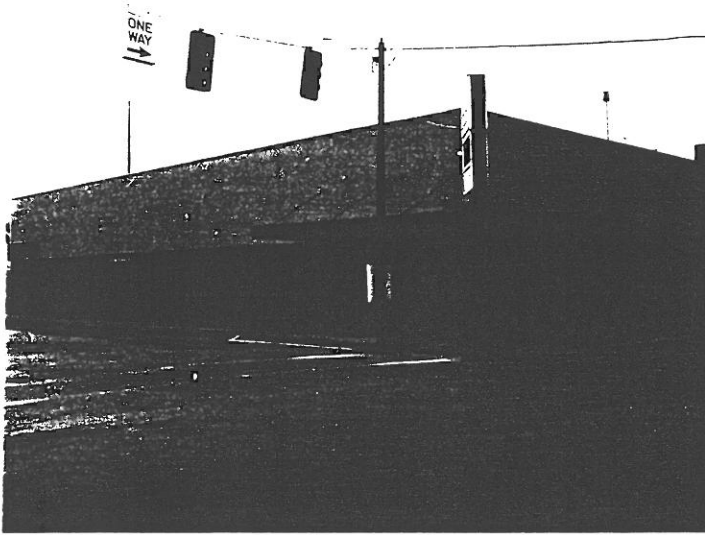

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

The First Federal Savings and Loan is a one-story brick building representing the Moderne style. The floor plan is rectangular, roof flat, and above the street level the walls are stuccoed. The main entry is on the north side of the west facade where full height windows are located. The southern half of the facade is a blank brick wall. A flat metal awning runs along the west facade and wraps around the first bay of the north facade. There is a projecting metal and glass corner sign above the awning.

The bay on the west end of the north facade has full height windows. A recessed entry is located at the center of the facade and there are six narrow, slot-shaped windows in the east half. The building was remodeled to its current condition in 1972 when the Savings and Loan business moved in.
